



ADDITIONAL NOTES ON THE AMPGS PROJECT

Employment

- At the peak of construction AMP expects the project to engage approximately 1,600 professional and skilled-trades workers.
- Once the plant is on-line, approximately 150 workers will operate and maintain the facility on a full-time basis. In addition, approximately 16 jobs will be associated with the fertilizer operation, which is planned to be associated with the facility as part of the Powerspan process.



Local Revenues

Based on an initial estimated project value of approximately \$1.5-2-billion, estimates show that the plant will contribute approximately \$20-million to the local economy. The updated estimate for construction costs, based on indicative pricing from the EPC contract, is \$3.074 billion.



Economic Development

The large number of people involved in the construction and operation of the plant will bring significant economic development to the area. Local businesses will see an increase in the number of people utilizing products and services.

Community Support

AMP will be a good neighbor and active participant in the community. Plant managers will look for ways to participate in the community and encourage employees to be actively involved as well.
